They are men and women willing to share their time and vehicle to help meet the transportation needs of their community. They provide nonemergency medical transportation for local and long distance trips.

How can you become a Volunteer Driver?

Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- Good driving record
- Current and valid driver's license
- Criminal background and drug screen
- Liability automobile insurance coverage
- Automobile which is safe and in roadworthy condition

The benefits of Volunteer Driving:

- Reimbursed at a rate of \$.50 per traveled mile
- Personal satisfaction of helping others
- FREE Emergency Kit
- Logisticare driver training

LogistiCare coordinates volunteer drivers to transport Medicaid Recipients to and from their medical appointments anywhere in Virginia. As a volunteer driver, you'll pick up riders and take them to their appointment. When their appointment is finished, you'll make sure they get home safely.
